Attendance Matters

St. Paulinus Catholic Primary Academy is committed to the continuous raising of ATTENDANCE achievement of all our pupils. Regular attendance is critical if our pupils are to be successful and benefit from the opportunities presented to them. Attendance and punctuality are important to allow children to achieve their full potential during their time at school.

As a school we consider attendance to be extremely important and would like the continued support of our parents in ensuring their child attends school regularly and on time. We have a zero tolerance policy on parents taking their children out of school to go on holiday. Kirklees Council will issue penalty notices or it may lead to fast track prosecution at the magistrate's court, if you are convicted, you could be fined up to £1000 and you will get a criminal record, this is regardless of your child's attendance percentage.

Attendance Absence

If we are unable to get hold of you within 45 mins of school registers being taken we will contact the next person your child's emergency list. If we are unable if we are unable to get hold of anyone we may arrange a home visit.

EYFS Nursery

Welcome to our 4 new nursery children who started in school on Tuesday. They have all settled in well into our school family.



Year 1

We have a new topic in art this term. We have been learning about drawing with different drawing techniques including zigzags, stippling and crosshatch. We used different mark makers to create a garden landscape with lots of wriggling worms.





Year 3

We have started the New Year with new topics that we are thoroughly enjoying! In **Science**, the children have been fascinated by the new subject of Light and Dark. In **P.E.**, we experienced yoga and are learning the 543 breathing technique. As part of the Epiphany, the children tasted a 'Galette des Rois' where one child who found the 'fève', was crowned King / Queen for the day.

Year 6 Life Skills Education: Lesson 10 – 'My Support Network'

This week was our final 'Life Skills' lesson and the focus was on our 'Support Networks'. We introduced the idea of a 'support network' using the definition: A person, group of people or an organisation you can go to for advice, information, help, encouragement, protection, or guidance. We highlighted the following people and organisations we could urn to if we ever needed help, support or guidance: Family, Teachers, School Nurture Team, NSPCC, Childline, Kooth, Talk to Frank etc. We also completed our Life Skills reports on what we had studied over the last 10 weeks and discussed what skills we have acquired that we can use in the future to keep us safe.
