### **Kirklees Admissions**

If your child is starting <u>SECONDARY SCHOOL</u> in <u>September 2024</u>, you must apply online between 1 September 2023 - 31 October 2023.

If your child is starting **PRIMARY SCHOOL (RECEPTION)** in <u>September 2024</u>, you must apply online between 1 September 2023 - 15 January 2024 (for children born between 1 September 2019 - 31 August 2020)

Apply online, apply on time
Name three preferences
Include your catchment school

If you apply late, your application will <u>NOT</u> be considered until all on time applications have been allocated school places. Applying late can severely reduce your chances of getting a school place at any of your preferred schools.

#### What do you need to do?

- Go to https://www.kirklees.gov.uk/admissions
- Read the relevant Admissions Guide for Parents.
- Click on 'Apply online'. You will be taken to the Kirklees Parent Portal.
- If this is your first visit, click on 'create an account'. Enter your details and follow the link to verify your account.
- Login to add your child's details and preferred schools.
- Check and submit your application.






#### Year 4
