Coppers for CAFOD – commenced 27th November 2023

Don't forget to donate your coppers for CAFOD. Last year we managed to buy all sorts of things for families living in poverty to support themselves e.g. buying queen bees so they could make honey or chickens for eggs. We also bought things to help them get water and mosquito nets to keep them safe at night. I wonder what we will buy this year?





The children can bring in their coppers (or larger denominations if you would prefer) at any point between Monday 27th November and Friday 15th December. As the common phrase goes, every little counts! Coppers may not hold much value on their own but once combined they can really change someone's life through this scheme.
