

Book Fair Summer 2024

It's that time of year again! The Book Fair will be arriving at school from the <u>24th - 28th June</u>. This is a popular annual event at school, and it is a great opportunity to select books and promote the love of reading with your child.

During the week, class teachers will accompany children to look at the books and give them an opportunity to see which books what could be of interest. There is something for every pocket at the book fair to assist with the rise in the cost of living - Approximately 30% of titles are under £5. Please note that if you still have a £1 World Book Day voucher these can be used at the event in part payment for a book.

After school, the option is available for children, accompanied by you, to purchase a book(s).

There will be a great selection of books on offer to inspire and entertain young readers and earn free books and resources for our school.

Parents can attend the Book Fair after school as follows:

Monday, 24th June EYU

Tuesday, 25th June Years 1 & 2 Wednesday, 26th June Years 3 & 4 Thursday, 27th June Years 5 & 6

The Book Fair will be taking place in the Dance Studio. Please enter school safely through the KS1 playground doors from 3:10 where a member of staff will direct you to the fair. The opening times are 3:10 - 3:40 each day.

Parents can pay for books with cash or alternatively while they're at the Fair using a QR code. This code will be displayed and available for download to your phone at the Book Fair and staff will be on hand to help.

For those parents who cannot attend but wish to buy books there is a **gift voucher option**. You can purchase electronic online vouchers. These gift vouchers are available to purchase at https://bookfairs.scholastic.co.uk/travelling-books/gift-vouchers. Once a purchase has been made, **you will receive the voucher in an email** which you can print and give to your child.

This means your child can choose books when they visit the Book Fair with their teacher. Please note that there is no change with the voucher system but there are some small items of stationary which can be purchased to ensure children use all their gift. Vouchers can be purchased up until midnight on the day before the collection of the Book Fair.
